

ASSESSING YOUR SCHOOLS LEVEL OF RISK

You will need to respond to the following based on the last 12 months but remember to take into account any future plans or developments which could have an immediate impact on the school or it's immediate surroundings. This allows you to determine the appropriate security category for your school perimeter fence.

1. TRESPASS - No cases of trespass in school grounds	0	1	2	3	4	5	Trespassers commonly in school grounds
